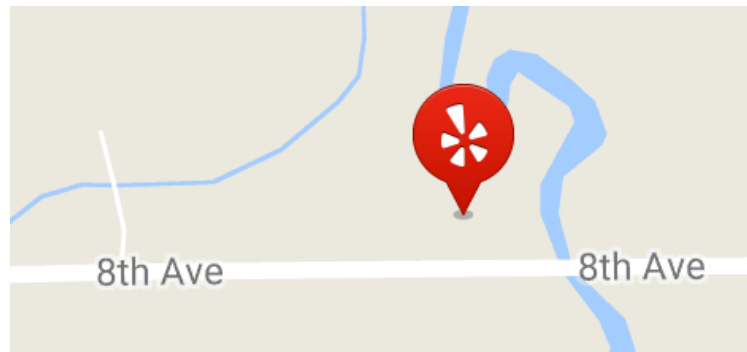


BLACK RIVER TRAILS CAMPGROUND RULES AND REGULATIONS

64480 8TH, South Haven, MI 49090



1. All persons entering the campground must register.
2. All campers must obtain a camping permit.
3. Campers may check in from 3.00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. but must register and occupy their campsite by 9:00 p.m. on the first night of their reservation or the campsite will be subject to re-rental and fees may be forfeited. Exceptions will be made with managers approval.
4. Campers must vacate their campsite no later than 11:00 a.m. on the final day.
5. Camping permits will not be issued for more than 14 nights. Exceptions may be made on availability of sites.
6. Permits will only be issued to persons at least 18 years old. In addition, they must have identification and proof of age, and furnish the full names of everyone in the camping party. The permit holder is responsible for the conduct of everyone under 18 years old and is liable for any violations of the rules and regulations.
7. All campers will occupy and utilize only their assigned campsite.
8. Unoccupied tents or other camping equipment unoccupied for more than 48 hours may be taken down and removed.
9. The use of electric generators may be limited to specific hours and with limitations. If you plan on using one, please see camp manager for more details.

10. Anyone who is not a registered camper is a visitor. Visitor hours are from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.
Visitors are not allowed between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m.
11. No fires are permitted outside of designated fire pits/rings.
12. Firewood cannot be gathered on site.
13. Fires cannot be left unattended.
14. Quiet must be observed between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
15. No person shall deface or remove campground signs, structures, barriers.
or remove or injure any plants, trees, flowers, on campground/river.
16. No person shall deposit garbage or refuse except in designated refuse containers.
17. No person shall possess fireworks.
18. No person shall engage in rough games or activities in campground except if designated areas are available.
19. No person shall discharge firearms on campground property.
20. No person under 21 years of age shall possess alcoholic beverages and campers who consume alcoholic beverages must produce adequate identification and proof of age upon request.
21. No person shall attempt to prevent employees from performing their duties by means of intimidation, physical force, or interference.
22. Violation of any campground rule is grounds for eviction. Anyone who is evicted is not entitled to a refund or to return for one week.
